

Mrs Krishnan's Party Audience FAQs

Where is the stage?

The whole theatre is set up as the back room of a convenience store and the action takes place all around you.

Will I be asked to perform?

No. It's really safe, gentle and fun.

How does the seating work?

The audience are like guests at the party. You can choose where you like to be:

- Right in the heart of the action (Top Table, Inner Circle, Cheeky Seats),
- Sit back and watch (Wallflowers).
- You can even stand up (Party Animal)

What is it like standing?

It's really fun. There are places to lean and you can move about a bit - like being a groundling at the Globe. It might just be the best place to experience this party.

How long is it?

75 minutes

What ages does it suit?

This is a show for all ages. Children from about ten accompanied by an adult and people of all walks of life right through to elders love the show. However the show is designed for adults and teens.

Do I need to be Indian to join in?

Onam is an Indian festival that brings people of all races and religions together. *Mrs Krishnan's Party* captures this spirit – but the party is for everyone.

Is there a dress code?

No. But if you'd like to evoke an Indian vibe - that would be great. So bright colours, scarves etc ...

What is Onam?

It's an Indian festival like Diwali or Holi. It originates in Kerala (South India) and is a bit like Christmas, Easter and New Year rolled into one.

Is it a party or a play?

It's a play. The story is about a party in the back room of a family run convenience store. The audience are guests at the party.

What is 'immersive theatre'?

The action takes place in and around where you are seated. You are 'immersed' in the world of the dairy.
